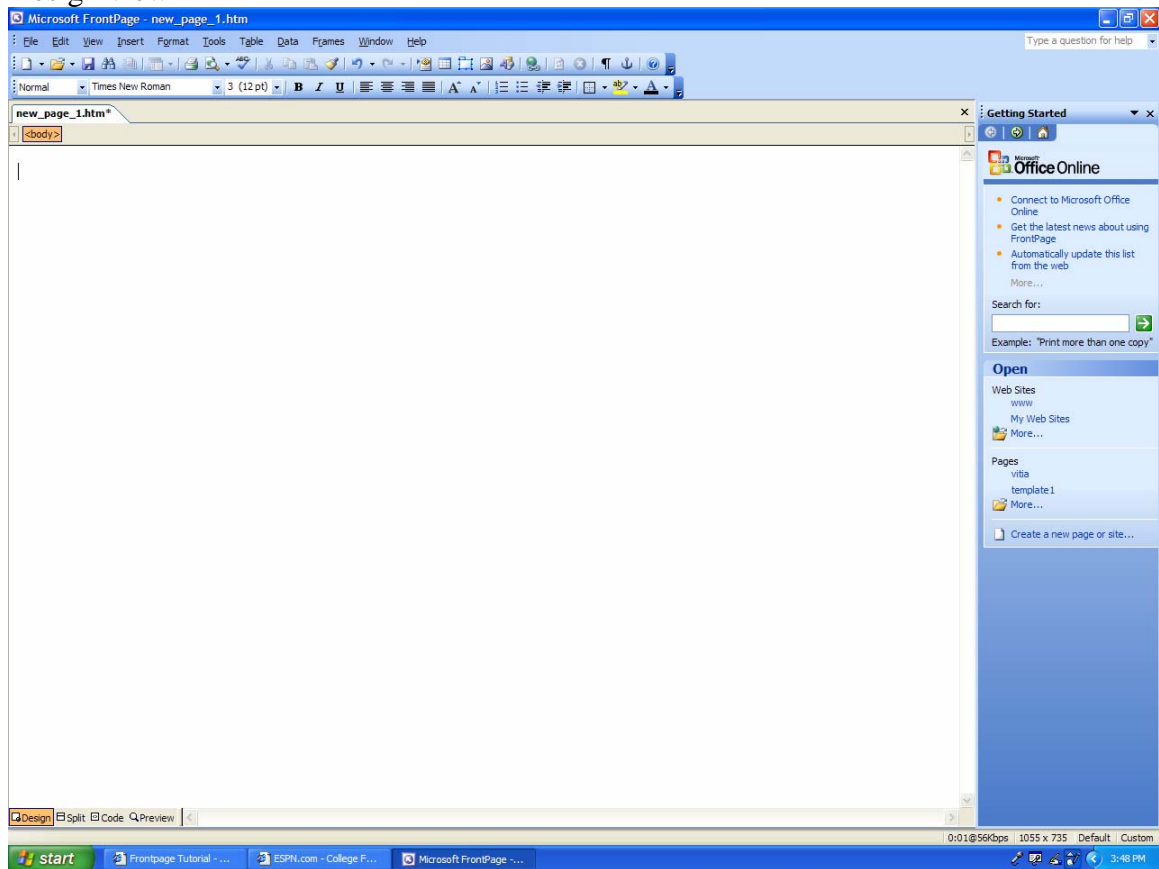
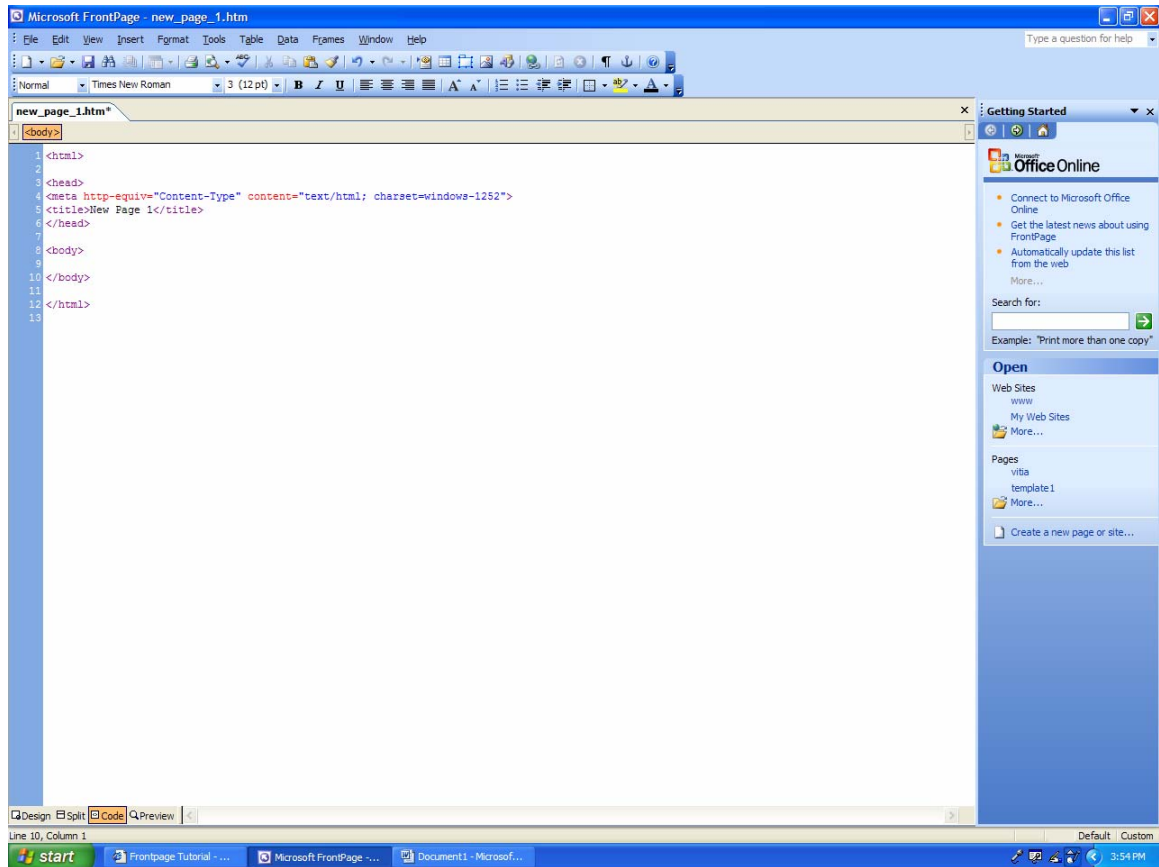


Design view



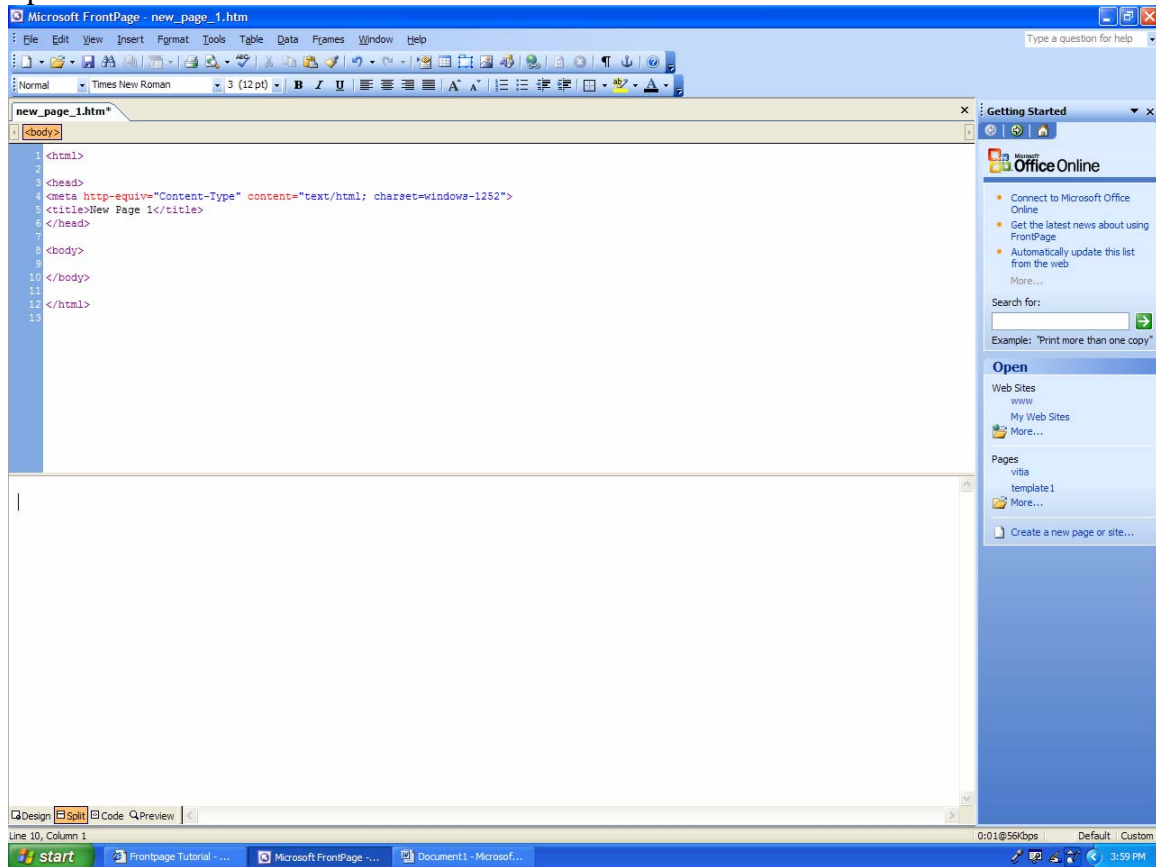
Design view is the default view of Microsoft Frontpage. It is a What You See Is What You Get (WYSIWYG) application. That means anything you put into the display screen will show up on the web as it is displayed in the document.

Code View



Code view provides view of Hypertext Markup Language (HTML) which provides for placement and objects on a webpage. This is a basic programming view for a webpage.

Spilt View



Split view allows you to work in design view or code view. Code view is at the top of the display and design view is at the bottom. This allows you to type code (in the code view) and see what it does in design view or allows you to work in design view and see what the corresponding code (HTML) is.
